Build Like a Beaver

Beavers use items in their habitats to build dams and lodges. Try building a model of a dam to see how they work.

WHAT BEAVERS USE	WHAT YOU NEED
Riverbed	9x13 inch (23x33 cm) disposable baking pan Play dough or clay
Logs and branches	Pop sticks
Mud	Play dough
Small stream	Pitcher of water

WHAT YOU DO

- 1. Cover the bottom of a baking pan with about 1 inch (2.5 cm) of play dough.
- 2. Carve a riverbed down the middle of the play dough.
- 3. Stack pop sticks across the riverbed to build a dam. Break the sticks into different lengths if you need to.
- 4. Use play dough to patch any gaps between the sticks.
- 5. Test your dam by gently pouring water into the river above the dam. Does it hold back the water? If not, try again.
